## Free Summer Project

**Make a fast, easy pillow/blanket for summer travel!**

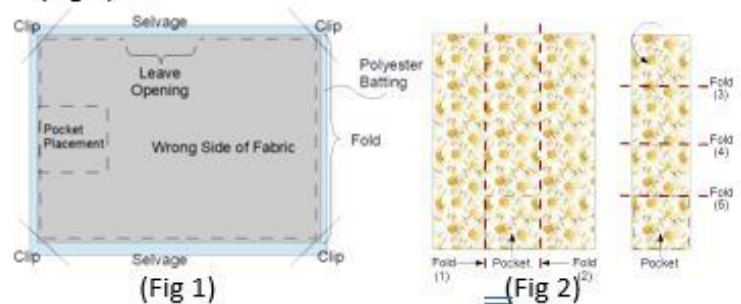
Materials needed:

3 yds main fabric

½ yd coordinating fabric

Polyester batting (crib sized - 45" X 60")

1. Fold the main fabric in half across the width of the fabric placing right sides together.
2. Place the folded fabric on top of the batting and pin around edges of fabric.
3. Sew a ¼" seam around all four edges, leaving a gap on the selvage to turn it right side out.
4. Clip the corners diagonally next to the stitching (Fig 1).



5. Turn right side out. Topstitch ¼" from edge of blanket on all 4 sides, catching the gap to close it. You can either "tie" the quilt by taking a stitch with yarn every 2-3 inches, or you can use a single decorative stitch on your sewing machine in place of the yarn.
6. Trim the coordinating fabric to 14 ½" X 28 ½".
7. Fold in half, right sides together, to make a square shape 14 ½" X 14 ½".
8. Stitch a ¼" seam around the three open sides, leaving an opening to turn it. Clip corners and turn right side out.
9. Place the coordinating fabric piece in the center at one end of the blanket, lining up the edges.
10. Stitch ¼" seam on 3 sides of the square piece leaving the opening on the top facing the middle of the blanket creating a "pocket".
11. Turn the blanket over so the pocket is facing down (Fig 2). Fold the blanket lengthwise in thirds. Then fold the blanket in fourths toward the pocket end. Turn the "pocket" inside out over the folded blanket. There is your travel pillow!
